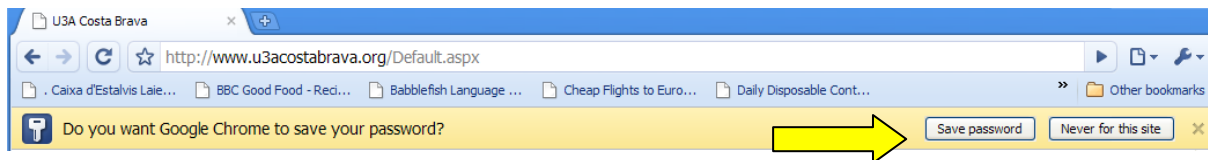


Google Chrome

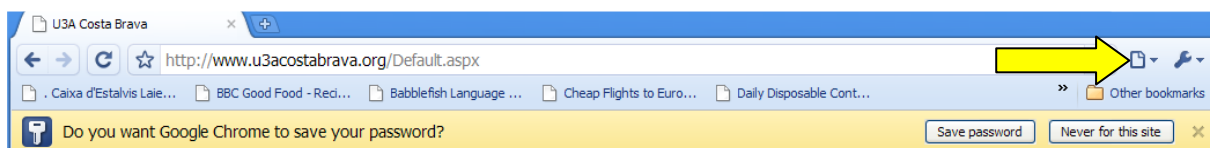
Fill in passwords automatically.

By default, Google Chrome is set up to remember passwords automatically if you would like it to do so. When you first type a password into a web form, you will be asked if you would like Google Chrome to remember the password. If you would like the password to be remembered, simply click 'Save password.'



If you are not asked whether you would like the password to be remembered, you need to turn on the AutoComplete feature.

To turn on the AutoComplete feature in Google Chrome, click the **Tools** button.



1. Then click **Options**.
2. Click the **Personal Stuff** tab.
3. Select '**Offer to save passwords**' and then '**close**'
